NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (STRO9054) affecting the **1) C877 The Street** from its junction with C201 Church Hill for 30m southwards and **2) C209 Low Road** from its junction with C877 The Street for 10m eastwards in the PARISH OF STARSTON to facilitate Norfolk County Council footway repair works.

Anti-Clockwise - Harleston Road, The Street, Wilderness Lane, London Road, The Thoroughfare, Redenhall Road, Station Road, Station Hill, Dicky Hill, Low Road. (Redenhall with Harleston, Needham, Starston, Pulham Market, Dickleburgh and Rushall, Tivetshall, Pulham St. Mary).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
